



#### **MORNING TRACKS:**



# FORGING A PATH TOWARDS INCLUSIVITY: HOW CENTRAL POLICY REFORMS AND REGIONAL GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES INTERSECT TO EMPOWER WOMEN'S ENTREPRENEURS IN KAZAKHSTAN

Nurlykhan, Shumaila, Nurlyaiym and Nurlan aare working on a paper that explores women's entrepreneurship in Kazakhstan, where gender-related challenges impede their business potential. Despite their global economic contribution, women face cultural barriers, policy gaps, and limited resources. The research identifies two main themes 1) The need for policy reforms supporting women's entrepreneurship, including gender-focused policies, equal resource access, tailored training, and financial literacy. 2) The significance of regional governments collaborating with women entrepreneurs via open dialogue, partnerships, and social media strategies.



## FROM MOTIVATION TO OPERATION: WHAT SHAPES THE ECO-BUSINESS LANDSCAPE IN KAZAKHSTAN?



Nurlyaiym and Shumaila are working on a paper that delves into the intricacies of circular entrepreneurship within Kazakhstan's SME sector. The research reveals the motivations propelling these businesses toward sustainable practices and the obstacles they encounter during this transformative journey. Based on meticulous interviews, the study explores the shifts in business models and the emergence of collaborative trends in the ecosystem. Positioned within the context of a resource-rich emerging economy, the findings furnish novel insights into sustainable entrepreneurial strategies, culminating in policy suggestions aimed at enhancing the circular economy landscape in Kazakhstan.

# THE CRAFT NARRATIVE OF UZBEKISTAN'S RESISTANCE: CREATIVE ENTREPRENEURSHIP DURING THE SOVIET OCCUPATION



One of the papers that our team is working on explores the phenomenon of creative entrepreneurship in Uzbekistan during the Soviet occupation through the lenses of resistance and decolonization. Challenging the dominant narrative of the Soviet occupation as a unilateral act of liberation and progress, the paper scrutinizes how creative entrepreneurs in Uzbekistan navigated the constraints of Soviet rule to preserve local culture, resist cultural homogenization, and maintain indigenous economic practices. The study illuminates the role of creative entrepreneurship as a form of resistance, asserting cultural identity, and contributing to the broader decolonization process in the region.


# THE EVOLUTION IN KAZAKHSTAN: THE EVOLUTION OF RETAIL ENTREPRENEURSHIP THROUGH TECHNOLOGY AND SOCIAL MEDIA



Zhansaule is working on a paper that explores the transformation of the retail landscape in Kazakhstan, driven by the rapid growth of digital commerce. It aims to shed light on how these entrepreneurs in Kazakhstan are adapting to digital advancements this and how transformative shift influencing is entrepreneurship and commerce in the country. Additionally, it explores the vital role of social media in driving sales and skills leveraging the sales entrepreneurs. In essence, this research endeavors to understand how Kazakhstani entrepreneurs in the retail sector are leveraging technology to revolutionize business operations, thereby reshaping the entrepreneurial landscape in the country.

# A QUINTUPLE HELIX MODEL (5HM) TO DEVELOP CIRCULAR ENTREPRENEURIAL ECOSYSTEMS







Shumaila and Juan Diego, a Post Doc at NURCE from the University of Huelva, Spain, are collaborating on a paper that delves into the intricacies of Circular Economy (CE). Despite the prevalent models such as the n-Rs, ReSOLVE, and the Triple Bottom Line (TBL), CE has yet to make a significant impact on the regional development of SMEs. By employing the Quintuple Helix model (5HM) as an analytical framework, their research explores the intersections of the micro, meso, and macro levels of CE, in tandem with TBL and institutional entrepreneurship within a southern Spanish context. Their findings underscore the transformative role of local universities, highlighting their potential to catalyze a transition towards a circular entrepreneurial ecosystem, emphasizing innovation, collaboration, and institutional harmonization. The duo also critique the current sustainability models within CE literature, emphasizing their potential inadequacies and the ambiguous linkages between sustainability objectives and the CE's operational tiers. The proposed university-centric circular ecosystem model, as advocated by Shumaila and Juan Diego, emerges as a seminal platform for discourse among regional policymakers, academicians, industry and stakeholders.

#### ANJAN GOSH'S BAY OF BENGAL FIELD TRIP







In October 2023, Prof Anjan Ghosh camped in an isolated environmentally vulnerable island ( the island has no electricity of internet) in the Bay of Bengal for three weeks. The island, in the last 15 years lost 56% of its landmasses due to sea level rise and soil erosion causing tens of thousands of the residents to become 'climate refugees'.

Professor Ghosh, in collaboration with esteemed scholars specializing in 'grand challenges' from ECCES Business School in France and Research lvey Business School in Canada, dedicated three weeks to this research endeavor. Their mission was to conduct a comprehensive ethnographic study aimed at understanding the coping mechanisms and responses of the island's residents to the harsh realities they face. This collaborative research initiative delves deep into the lives of those residing in environmentally vulnerable regions. By immersing themselves in the community, the researchers aim to unravel the intricate ways in which these resilient individuals respond to the challenges posed by climate change, exploring their adaptive strategies and resilience in the face of adversity.


